- I will make no attempt to identify or contact any individual study participant except in situations where the participant has to be called back for retesting with the prior approval from the Director of the LoNG, Professor Ahmad R. Hariri.

- I will make sure to use appropriate safeguards to prevent use or disclosure of the information other than as provided in the agreement.
